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*Camp Susquehannock, Inc. announced the "Campaign for Camp" today with a mission to raise \$1,000,000 by the end of 2021. To kick off the campaign one gracious alum has agreed to fund the construction of a new dock/waterfront.*

*This Marks the Largest Campaign in the Camp`s Recent History.*

*Its goals are simple: Upgrade the facilities, maintain the rustic charm/tradition of Susquehannock and eliminate the financial barriers to a summer camp experience.*

Here are ways you can give back to Camp Susquehannock. Now, more than ever, Camp Susquehannock needs your support!

### **#1. Adopt and Send a Child to Camp**

There are countless children in need of the Susquehannock experience but simply can't afford it. By agreeing to pay for a child or multiple children to attend camp we will send you a qualified applicant to sponsor. The Sponsorship will be in your name or whatever name you choose (Example: The Smith Family Susquehannock Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to one deserving 11 year old child each year.) You can follow the progress of this child throughout the summer and see exactly how your generosity is impacting their growth and development.

\*Half Season Partial Scholarship: \$2,000 Donation

Goal: 20 partial scholarship per year (\$40,000) totaling: \$80,000

\*Half Season Full Scholarship: \$4,500 Donation

Goal: 20 full scholarships per year (\$90,000) totaling: \$180,000

### **#2. The Scholarship Fund**

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For those who want to support a deserving child but can't afford to cover a full or partial scholarship. Simply make a donation of your choice earmarked for scholarships and the money will be pooled and used to help bring deserving young children to camp. This includes our Alumni Challenge.

**#3. Capital Improvements**

Camp is embarking on a capital improvements campaign designed to not only improve our existing facilities but do it in way that maintains the charm and rustic family feel we have come to know as Camp Susquehannock. This includes:
