Camp Susquehannock Continues Historic Capital Campaign

**In September of 2019 Camp Susquehannock, Inc. Announced The
“Campaign for Camp” With A Goal To Raise \$1,000,000.**

Through August 2020 the Campaign has reached a total of \$390,573. A new dock and guest dock were constructed. The boys’ and girls’ basketball courts were resurfaced. The girls now have a new multi-sport platform that plays host to tennis, street hockey and basketball.

New roofs were built over the kitchen, lodge, and a variety of cabins. New maintenance and athletic equipment were purchased, and Sponsorship/Scholarship was provided for ten children who otherwise could not attend camp.

The goals are simple: Upgrade the facilities, maintain the rustic charm/tradition of Susquehannock and eliminate the financial barriers to a summer camp experience.

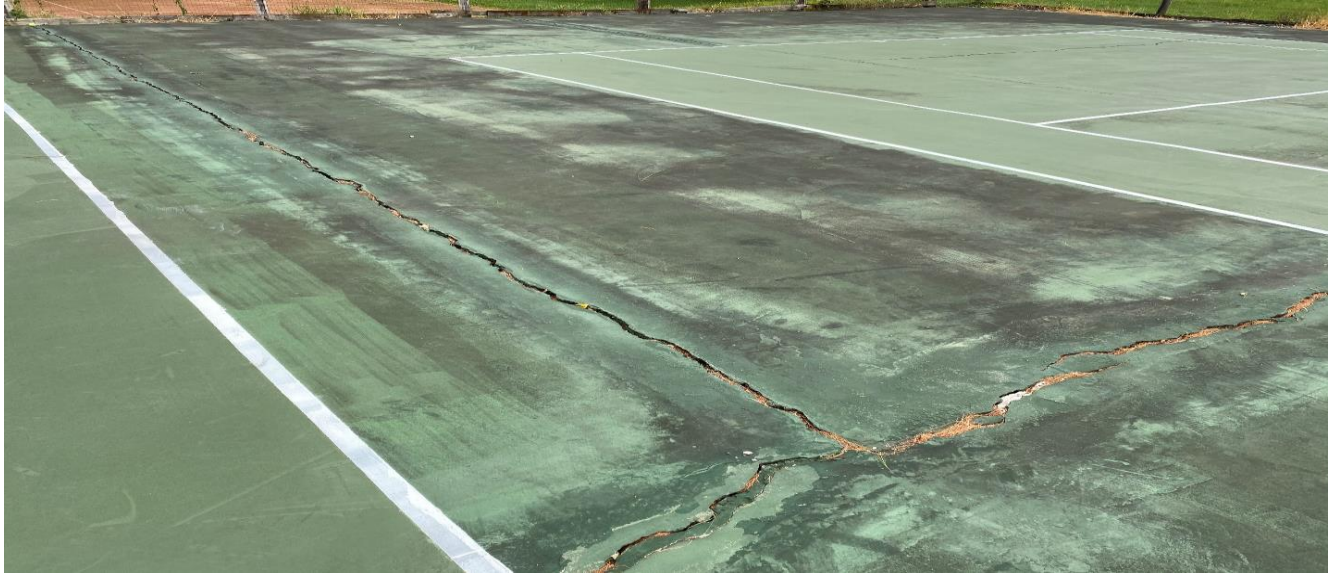
Here Are The Ways You Can Help Today !

#1. Re-Construct Hard Courts 2 & 3 in the Hill Camp The courts are in bad condition. They are unplayable and unsafe. The construction plan is to completely rebuild the courts and convert the surface into a multi-sport platform that will host tennis, basketball, and street hockey. As you can see from the pictures below this project cannot wait any longer. Your help is needed today! **Total Cost: \$125,000** (we have already received \$20,000 toward this goal)

Camp Susquehannock Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization providing multi-sport athletic development and confidence-based learning for children between the ages of seven and sixteen. All contributions to camp are tax deductible.



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#2. Adopt and Send a Child to Camp

There are countless children in need of the Susquehannock experience but simply can't afford it. By agreeing to sponsor a child or multiple children to attend camp we will select a qualified young child to be the beneficiary of your gift. The Sponsorship could be in your name or

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whatever name you choose (Example: The Smith Family Susquehannock Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded to one deserving 11-year-old child each year.) You can follow the progress of this child throughout the summer and see exactly how your generosity is impacting their growth and development.

*Half Season Partial Sponsorship: \$2,500 Donation

*Half Season Full Sponsorship: \$4,800 Donation

#3. Capital Improvements

The capital improvements campaign is designed to not only improve our existing facilities but do it in way that maintains the charm and rustic family feel we have come to know as Camp Susquehannock. This includes:

Restoration of the Existing Buildings:

- New Roofs (Icehouse, Cab Inn/Mount Inn, Girls & Boys Club, Post Office, Health Center, Library) \$35,775
- Re-wire, New Floors, Stairs, Bunks (Seldom Inn, Mr. Ps` House, Peek Inn, Palace, Study Hall) \$27,000

Remodel of Existing Kitchen: Floor, Appliances, Storage, Walk-In Refrigeration, Freezer \$40,000

Upgrade Main Lodge & Dining Hall: Re-wire, Generator, Additional Seating, Stairs, Paint, Bunks, Refurbish floors \$30,000

Improve Main Office & Water Tower: Stairs, Siding, Ladder \$6,000

Restore Senior Staff Buildings: Floors, Bathroom, Siding \$35,000

#5. The Annual Giving:

Your donation, no matter what size will be used to support the daily maintenance of camp which includes yearly paint, new sports equipment, power tools, lawn equipment and the myriad of other things that need to be done on a yearly basis.

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#6. Dasher Board/Walls for the Girls Street Hockey Court

*Last year a new street hockey court was built for the girl's camp, but we were unable to secure the final piece of funding for the walls/dasher boards: \$25,000
